Deadline for admission to begin the **Transition semester** in the fall is **February 1st to March 15th**.

Deadline for admission to begin the **Transition semester** in the Spring is **September 1st to October 15th**.

Students accepted into the LPN-to-RN for Advanced Standing Program will be notified via student email. Students are required to attend a **MANDATORY orientation** prior to the semester program courses begin. Dates are announced in the admission letter. Students who do not attend may reapply for the next RN application cycle.

The following courses are required **once admitted** to the LPN-to-RN for Advanced Standing program to complete the Nursing, Associate in Applied Science Degree.

All coursework must be completed with a C or better to continue in the next semester.

BIO 142 (Anatomy & Physiology II - 4 cr.) must be completed prior to the Transition Semester.

Students must apply to the Nursing program prior to the Transition Semester.
