*** The Part time program students have the option of online or in-person courses. All nursing courses will have in-person tests, labs, simulations, and clinicals. Lab, simulation, and clinical requirements will be scheduled according to facility availability during daytime and evening hours.

Evening and weekend labs and clinicals are NOT guaranteed.

Students accepted into the Part-Time RN Program will be notified via student email. Students are required to attend a **MANDATORY orientation** prior to the semester program courses begin. Dates are announced in the admission letter.

Students who do not attend may reapply for the next Part-Time RN application cycle.

The following courses are required **once admitted** to Part-Time RN program to complete the *Nursing, Associate in Applied Science Degree*. **All coursework must be completed with a C or better to continue in the next semester.**
