This checklist is provided to assist you in completing your application to the Future Educators Academy. You are responsible for ensuring that all of your application materials are completed and submitted to your counselor **no later than January 30, 2025.** 

- Read and follow all directions very thoroughly and carefully.
- Make sure all student information is provided on the on-line Germanna Future Educators Academy Student Application.
- Provide your counselor with the Student Profile page by January 23, 2025. Counselors complete this page
- Upload the following forms:
  - o A signed Parent Permission Form
  - A signed Commitment Form
  - Your Counselor Recommendation (signed by your counselor)
- Completion of Algebra II with a grade of "C" or higher is required by end of Spring 2025 semester.
- Students are required to have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher in order to dual enroll college transfer courses. If GPA is less than 3.0, make arrangements to take the Virginia Placement Tests in English and Mathematics. Students must meet basic math and English requirements to dual enroll. Courses also have additional prerequisite requirements. Appropriate SAT or ACT scores may be used to satisfy course prerequisites, depending on the course. Contact your high school Counselor, Career Coach, or the Dual Enrollment office at the community college for assistance. Attach a copy of Virginia Placement Test results for English and Math with your application materials.
- Students will be notified of acceptance to the Academy by April 11, 2025.
